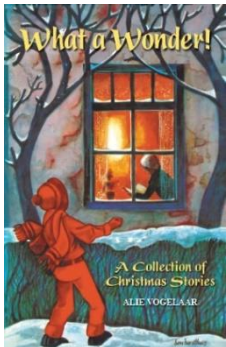
Beacon by Ministers of the NRC
